12/18 Declarations of Interest

J Kearl declared an interest.

13/18 To consider a request from Main Street residents for a grant to fund Land Survey works for a new field drain to resolve a grey water issue in Main Street. Residents are meeting the cost of the new drain.

The request was submitted by the Flood Group on behalf of those residents affected by the issue of the removal of grey water and surface run-off from the road gullies in Main Street. A new field drain (funded by a number of village residents) will improve the discharge of the water into the ditch system. The Land Survey of the ditch system is required to inform the design and protection of the new field drain. The proposed work will benefit a significant number of the residents in Main Street and improve the land drainage system for the village. The work needs to be completed by 1st April.

Resolved: The Parish Council will award a grant under S137 to cover the cost of the Land Survey work, expected to be in the region of £300. The invoice will be sent to the Clerk of the Council for payment.

Resolved: The costs will be met from the Sundries budget.
